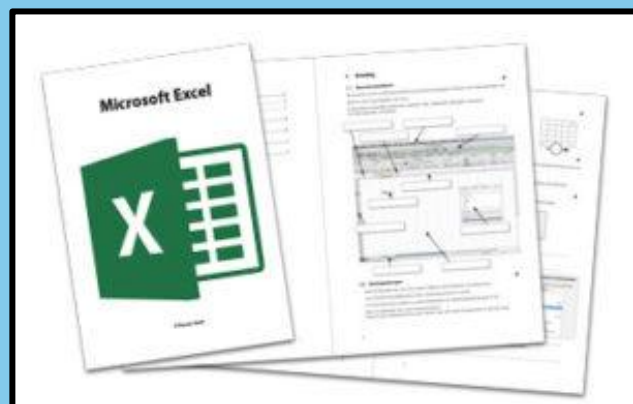




Accountant at a large accounting firm.
